Marc Mondavi's
The Divining Rod 2012 "Divine Red"

Winemaking Notes:



"Our winemaking philosophy is to use a gentle hand and let the quality of the vineyards shine through. As such, our oak aging provides subtle, toasty notes while the ripeness and vibrancy of the fruit takes center stage. We used new medium-toast French oak to give our Divine Red the structure it deserved. This blend of Zinfandel, Cabernet Sauvignon and Petite Sirah gives 'divine' balance and complexity to the wine."

Tasting Notes:

"Our Divine Red with its deep, rich, red color opens with aromas of blackberry, cedar and cinnamon. The blackberry and black pepper flavors are complemented by hints of plum and cassis, giving the wine depth and complexity."

"New French oak adds a pleasant mouth feel, texture and weight giving the right amount of influence to envelop the wine in a fitting tannic structure and a long finish that preserves the integrity and brightness of the Lodi fruit."

"Our Divine Red allows Marc to work his magic with premium Zinfandel, Cabernet Sauvignon and Petite Sirah grown in the Lodi appellation in Northern California. Lodi, with its classic Mediterranean climate, enjoys warm days and cool nights thanks to cool delta breezes originating from the San Francisco Bay. It's the perfect climate."

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Some highlights

Terrunyo Carmenere: From Block 27, Peumo Vineyard, Rapel Valley, Chile. Terrunyo Carmenere has complex and elegant aromas of ripe red berries, plum, spice and a hint of tobacco. Wine Enthusiast 92 points!

San Angelo Pinot Grigio: from Montalcino, Tuscany (Italy), this exceptional Pinot Grigio is very fresh and fruity, with pear, banana, peach, anise and honey notes. 100% Pinot Grigio, estate bottled.

Wilhelm Bergmann Riesling - Spätlese

Piesporter Goldtröpfchen: Piesport's most famous vineyards are the south-facing slopes of Goldtröpfchen, where this wonderfully sweet—but not cloying—classic German white wine is produced.

J. Lohr "Hilltop" Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon: this luscious Paso Robles (CA) Cab is aromatically pleasing with intense flavors of black cherry, blackberry and toasted vanilla. The back label of this bottle tells an incredible winemaking story of this work of art!

Gloria Ferrer Carneros Merlot: This Estate Merlot has complex aromas of black currant, plum and blackberries with a touch of mint and cedar on the nose. On the palate, it displays great balance and body with exuberant plum, red cherry and mocha hints creating a long and full finish.
